The exterior envelope of the sealed bids shall be marked "New Orleans East Hospital, ED Ramp Addition Project Number N16041\_16028" and shall prominently display the bidder's name, contact information and license number. Bids received after 11:00AM on Friday, June 2, 2017 will not be considered and shall be returned to the bidder.
- F. Each bid shall be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check, or bid bond payable to the Owner, the amount of which shall be five percent (5%) of the base bid. If a bid bond is used, it shall be written by a surety or insurance company currently on the U.S. Department of the Treasury Financial Management Service list of approved bonding companies which is published annually in the Federal Register, or by a Louisiana domiciled insurance company with at least an A- Rating in the latest printing of the A.M. Best's Key Rating Guide to write individual bonds up to ten percent of policyholders' surplus as shown in the A.M. The Owner reserves the right to reject any and all bids for just cause in accordance with Title 38 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes.
