WHEREAS, Louisiana's FQHCs are providing over one million medical, oral and

behavioral health patient visits to more than 344,000 individual patients annually, many of whom live in medically underserved

and rural areas of our state; and

WHEREAS, Louisiana's FQHCs, which are spread throughout the state in over

> 220 individual facilities, are tasked with treating those patients who do not have the financial benefit of health insurance coverage as well

as those who rely on Medicaid and Medicare; and

WHEREAS, in addition to providing cost-effective care, Louisiana's FQHCs

remain vigilant in adhering to the most stringent clinical requirements in their commitment to offer the highest quality of patient care and

safety; and

WHEREAS, Louisiana's FQHCs, along with the Louisiana Primary Care

> Association, stand ready to work even more closely with the state in continuing to provide the highest quality of care to our state's citizens

in Louisiana's most medically underserved areas; and

WHEREAS, Louisiana's participation in National Health Center Week offers the

> opportunity to cherish and celebrate the fantastic work done by Louisiana's FQHCs and recognize the important role they play as

health innovators in their communities.
