Station Name: "PC-13"

Monument Location: The station is located in Pointe Coupee Parish, LA, 4.7 miles Southeast of Innis, LA, 6.8 miles North of Morganza, LA and 7.5 miles Southwest of Tunica, LA. To reach the station from the intersection of LA HWY 1 and LA HWY 972, travel East on LA HWY 972 for 2.2 miles to the intersection of LA HWY 419, turn left on LA HWY 419 and go North for 0.6 miles to the station on the right.

Monument Description: The monument is a 9/16 inch stainless steel rod found in good condition and encased by a 6 inch PVC pipe with an aluminum access cover stamped "PC-13". The station is 29.0 feet North of the centerline of LA HWY 419, 35.1 feet Southeast of an "OLD RIVER LANDING" sign and 57.6 feet Southeast of a power pole. An orange carsonite witness post is 1.0 feet North of the station.
