Station Name: "PC-20"

Monument Location: The station is located in Pointe Coupee Parish, LA, 9.0 miles South-Southwest of Morganza, LA, 4.0 miles North of Lottie, LA and 1.9 miles Northwest of Fordoche, LA. To reach the station from the intersection of LA HWY 81 and LA HWY 77 (Fordoche Rd.) in Fordoche, LA, travel Northwest on LA HWY 77 for 1.1 miles to the station on the left.

Monument Description: The station is a 9/16 inch stainless steel rod set and encased by a 6 inch PVC pipe with an aluminum access cover stamped "PC-20". The station is 47.6 feet Southeast of power pole # 139A, 63.0 feet Northwest of a gas meter, 58.0 feet Southwest of the centerline of Fordoche Rd., and 136 feet North-Northwest of the Northwest corner of a small wooden house. An orange carsonite witness post was placed 2.2 feet to the West of the monument for identification purposes.
